There have been reports of damage to dried fruit properties across the region following yesterday's storm.

Rows of vines have blown over, pump sheds have taken off, and trees have fallen on houses, sheds and farm equipment.

Growers in Merbein and Red Cliffs seem to be the worst affected, and have many rows of Swingarm to pick up off the ground.
