Merbein South grower Robert Collins has a cutter bar set up to summer prune his vertical trellis system, and will be demonstrating how it works tomorrow at 10am.

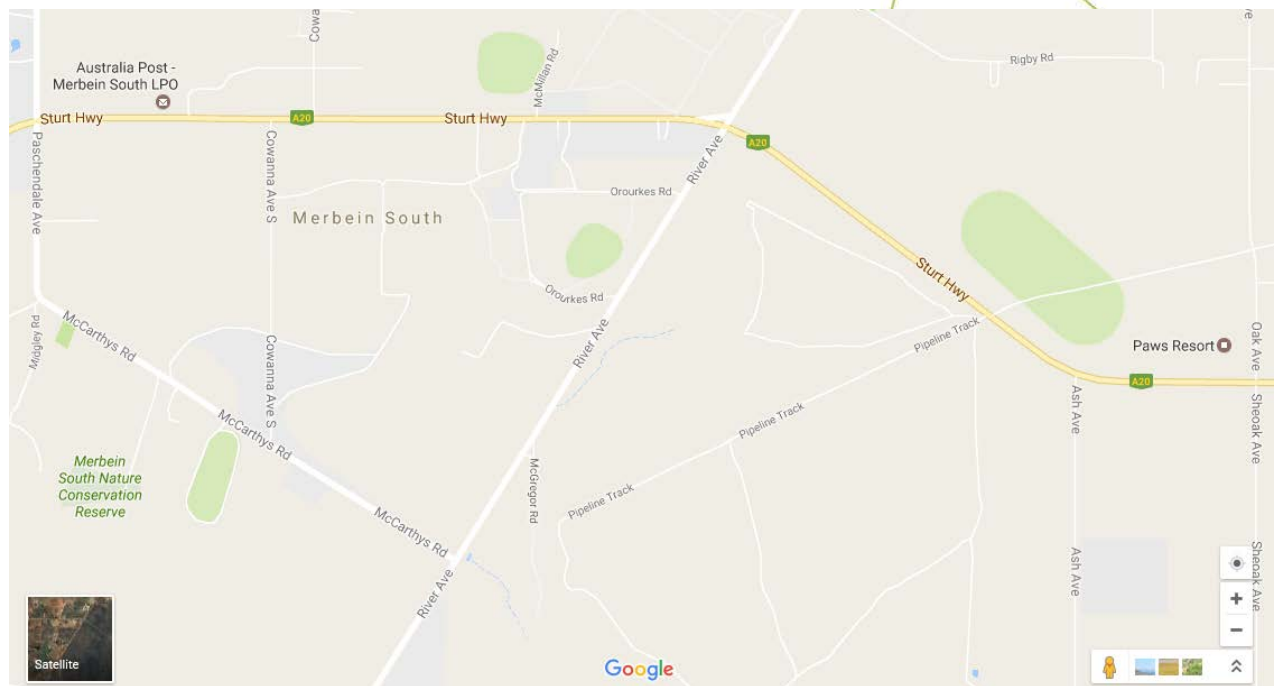
Date: Friday 3 March 2017
